

NJTTC CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Respect for fellow members and players is encouraged and appreciated.
2. Respect for the table tennis equipment and the club's facility is a must. (For example, players may not kick, pound or sit on the tables, nor may they place beverage containers or other items on them.)
3. All members are responsible for cleaning up after themselves and making sure that garbage and recyclables are put into the appropriate receptacles.
4. Practice good sportsmanship. No cursing or use of obscenities will be tolerated. There will be zero tolerance for violence or threatening behavior. Players who repeatedly and egregiously degrade the club's environment with verbal or physical abuse will be suspended or banned from the club.
5. No children may be left unattended. Parents are responsible for their children's behavior.
6. No use of alcohol or drugs.
7. Players must dress appropriately and must wear table tennis shoes or sneakers while playing.
8. Players and spectators will refrain from disruptive noises or gestures which may distract the players.
9. No soliciting on the premises. This covers any type of table tennis business - including tournaments, equipment sales, or coaching that has not been approved by the management.
10. Membership dues must be paid on time in order to maintain one's membership. Non-members play according to guest player policy (one free tryout visit allowed).
